

Dr. Sr. Jasintha Quadras, fmm, took up the office as the eighth Principal of Stella Maris College on May 1, 2008. As an academician and administrator, she expanded academic opportunities for students and charted the future of Stella Maris for the next generation.

Sr. Jasintha did her M.Phil and Doctorate in Mathematics in the University of Madras. She specialised in Graph Theory and her research was titled 'Embeddings and Interconnection Networks'. In addition, she had a Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Applications from Stella Maris College and an MS in Computer Science from Marquette University, USA.

She joined the faculty of the Department of Mathematics in 1996, and held the additional post of Director, Department of Computer Science, Stella Maris College from 1996 to 2000. During this time, she conceptualised and set up one of the earliest state-of-the-art computer labs in the college and helped design the syllabus for the BCA degree programme which was introduced in 1998. She has been M.Phil Supervisor for research students of Mathematics from 2003 onwards and has been sanctioned a three year research project by the Science & Engineering Research Board of the DST, Government of India in 2017.

She visited many Institutions around the world and participated in the international meetings, which empowered her to enhance the international standard of the College.
