In her invocatory address, Dr. Sr. Stella Mary fmm prayed for peace to return to the troubled region and through dialogue and mutual understanding, resolve all differences between the warring peoples. She exhorted them to call upon their faith and trust in humanity for the will to live in peaceful co-existence amidst differences.
