Crime: Honour Killing, Stabbed to death with billhooks, at Murugesan Nagar in Thoothukudi on 19 th March 2024.</p> <p>Transcript of the interview with the eyewitness (Latha,30)</p> <p>Interviewer: Thank you for joining us. Can you tell us about your relationship with Mariselvam and Karthiga? Witness: Mariselvam and Karthiga were my neighbors in Murugesan Nagar, Thoothukudi. They were a lovely couple, always very private but seemed deeply in love. I didn't know them well personally, but I often saw them together and they seemed happy. Interviewer: How did you learn about the tragic incident that took their lives? Witness: It was around 6 pm on Thursday when I heard loud noises coming from Mariselvam and Karthiga's house. I went outside to see what was happening, and that's when I saw a group of men on bikes leaving their house. It all happened so fast, and before I knew it, there was chaos and screams. Interviewer: Did you witness anything that could help identify the perpetrators? Witness: Yes, I saw six men leaving on three bikes. They wore helmets, and I couldn't see their faces clearly. Interviewer: Was there any history of threats or conflict involving Mariselvam and Karthiga? Witness: I didn't know much about their personal lives, but I heard rumors about their families being against their relationship. It's heartbreaking to think that their love story ended in such a tragic way. Interviewer: Thank you for sharing your insights with us during this difficult time.</p> <p>Comment by the police: The investigation into the tragic deaths of Mariselvam and Karthiga is ongoing.
