Chennai: With more than 35 events and 70 artists participating, Art Chennai 2014 will be nothing short of grand, spanning more than nine days.

Starting today, the city's art lovers can revel in the best of modern and contemporary art. The event, on till February 16 at various loca-

tions, will showcase art work including paintings, drawings, installations, sculptures and photography.

The host of exhibitions have been themed around 'Environment, Heritage and Conservation' and has been conceived by Girish Shahane, who is the festival's artistic director.

The organisers of the event say that with the third

edition of the art festival, the event has grown bigger and is an attempt to engage the whole city in art. From public spaces to galleries and a host of other venues in the city, the festival will bind Chennai in the language of art.

Art Chennai 2014 will also have a few educational institutions like IIT Madras and Stella Maris College of-

fering space to display art work.

As Sanjay Tulsyan, the convenor of the festival puts it, "There is something for all spectrum of society and the same will be seen at multiple locations like the beach, malls, public building spaces, information technology parks, arts colleges and also star hotels and galleries across the city."
